1. Course fees must be paid prior to visa application for non-EU students.
2. A compulsory fee of €300 is due to be paid in addition to the above fees in respect of medical insurance and administration charges. 3. These fees are fixed at the most economic price possible. No negotiation of fees will be entertained.
4. Course fees must be discharged by SWIFT Transfer which will be supplied in the provisional offer letter to non-EU students. For security reasons, no cash can be accepted.
5. Course fees are not refundable.
6. Course commencement is dependent on student demand and course fees will not be refunded once a course has commenced.
Course commencement and start date are dependent on a viable cohort formation
7. Course fees quoted are for the academic year 2010/2011 only. Course fees in future years are subject to price reviews.
8. Griffith College Cork reserves the right to change any of the details or regulations on its web-site or in any brochure.
9. Currency payments are translated into Euros and credited to students at the rate applicable on the date remittance is processed through the College's bank account.
10. Students classified for fee purposes as non-EU, will not be permitted to change their fee status following admission, irrespective of holding a work permit or studying a part-time course.
11. Students may be transferred to its Dublin campus to complete any portion of the programme, at the discretion of the College.
12. If a student has to repeat a semester or subjects of a semester, then the student will be billed for a full semester.
13. All students for whom English is not their first language will be required to sit an English language test prior to the commencement of their course. Students whose level of English does not meet the required standard may be redirected onto a Pre-University course in Griffith College. There is no charge for this. However, for each additional three months required, there will be a charge of €1500. This fee is separate to fees secured already.
